

A BRIEF HISTORY OF WUS POOL

WAYLAND UNION SCHOOLS HAS HAD A POOL FOR 48 YEARS. THE POOL HAS SERVED OUR COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL WELL, BUT IT'S TIME FOR AN UPDATE.



MARCH 1999

Bond Proposal = \$3,995,000 passes. Major work is remodeling of elementary buildings to add new classroom wings.

1975

Wayland Union Schools opens a pool. Community use includes PE swim lessons, community open swim, competition, fitness classes for all, and summer swim lessons for all ages.



MAY 2008

Pool replacement **considered** as part of new Bond proposal presented to voters.

MAY 2008

Pool replacement **removed** from potential Bond projects due to cost and needs of other priority projects.

MAY 2008

Bond = \$38,930,000 passes with **no pool** on the ballot. Major project is the FAC in this proposal as well as considerable work at all buildings.

2015-16

Major Pool Pak Repairs, but pool is no longer legal to dive into from starting blocks. Pool is running, but not reliable.



2016

New pool is officially part of the Bond proposal = \$54,945,000. May 2017 Bond proposal fails

2017

District redesigns Bond proposal = \$19,250,000 to eliminate pool from the ballot issue. November 2017 Bond passes.

Major work is the addition of the 8th grade wing at the middle school.

2022

Bond proposal = \$48,500,000 includes a new pool. August 2022 Bond proposal fails by 225 votes

2023

Bond proposal = \$49,700,000 includes a new pool. May 2023 - Proposal is the same work - projects are still a NEED!
