The Annetta Jansen Ministry Center houses three main ministries; Annetta's Garage Thrift Store, Annetta's Pantry food pantry and the Project Hope Clearinghouse program. The center is open five days a week from 10 am-5 pm, and on Thursdays, we are open until 7:30 pm. Donations are accepted on Mondays from 9:30 am - 4:30 pm and Thursdays 3:00 pm—7:30 pm. Food is given by appointment only. There are eleven paid staff and over 200 volunteers helping to keep this vital ministry running smoothly.

Annetta's Pantry

Annetta's Pantry provides groceries for those in need in Northeast Allegan County. The Pantry serves approximately 400 families per month. Clients meet with a Christian greeter who talks with and prays for them before they start the grocery shopping process. Clients are then scheduled to return on a monthly basis. The client also receives a coupon for 50% off their purchases at *Annetta's Garage* thrift store to meet the needs of their family.

Project Hope Compassionate Care - Ministry (Clearinghouse Program)

This program helps families find resources for such needs as utility shut-offs, eviction notices, car repairs, prescriptions, etc. All needs are verified and evaluated and the best resource is found to meet that need.

Project Hope partners with over 40 area churches as well as local agencies to find these much needed resources. It is our prayer that through these connections, a family may find a "church home".

This program serves clients in the Northeast Allegan County area. Applications are taken over the phone and by appointment.

Annetta's Garage Thrift store

Annetta's Garage Thrift Store is open to all who like to get great deals! Items offered are clothing, shoes, household goods, linens, toys, jewelry, and much more. All funds raised from Annetta's Garage directly fund the operations of the Annetta Jansen Ministry Center.

A voucher system is set in place for those experiencing a time of hardship in their lives and find themselves needing basic living supplies. (Examples: loss because of a fire or flood, prison re-entry, domestic abuse or clothing needed for job interviews, etc.) This system allows them to receive these much needed items at no cost.
