\$20.00 wage/hour for Water Safety Instructor.  
Number/certification of lifeguards is dependent on the size of the group (1:15) and must be coordinated with the Fitness Center Director.

**Pool Rental:**

Pool rental use outside of WUS district related athletics is based on availability and direct/indirect cost of facility, plus lifeguards, plus custodial services, plus trash services. To be quoted at time of request.
