Lifeguards Contracted Wages:

 \$15.00 wage/hour for 0 – 1 year of lifeguard experience.

 \$17.00 wage/hour for 3 years and up of lifeguard experience.
 \$20.00 wage/hour for Water Safety Instructor

Number/certification of lifeguards is dependent on the size of the group (1:15) and must be coordinated with the Fitness Center Director.

Pool Rental:

Pool rental use outside of WUS district related athletics is based on availability and direct/indirect cost of facility, plus lifeguards, plus custodial services, plus trash services.
