YOUTH ENRICHMENT



Off Road Vehicle (ORV)

Safety Certification (ages 11+)

In ORV Safety/Certification class, you will learn safe and responsible off-road vehicle operation in a classroom setting.

An ORV Safety Certificate is required for all operators under 16 years of age. Although, not required by Michigan law, adults are allowed to take the course. Please bring your own sack lunch. Class material will be provided at the start of the class. Students will not be riding ORVs.

The main purpose of the ORV safety education course is to educate and develop safe, knowledgeable, and responsible ORV owners and operators. Topics covered include correct riding techniques, protective equipment, understanding terrain and trail operation, laws, and regulations, causes and prevention of crashes, and environmental concerns and reporting responsibility.

Any ORV operator 16 years old and younger riding on public or private land is required to pass an approved ORV safety course.
