

Advanced Theatre

Course Description:

This one-trimester course is in place for students who wish to participate in the school plays. The class is used for completion of both rehearsals and all technical aspects of the theatre. It is designed for students who are committed (beyond in-class work) to the art of theatre. The class is open to 10-12 grade students, by audition.

Course Objectives:

This course involves the students in all aspects of the production of a full-length school play. This course is also moving into the educational outreach, and directing directions.

Student Objectives:

The Student will...

- 1) Create a performance for a paying audience. (C.1, C.2, C.3, C.4, C.5, P.1, P.2, P.3, P.4, R.1, R.2, R.3, R.4)
- 2) Perform many of the necessary duties involved with a full-length performance. This includes, but is not limited to: acting, directing, dramaturgy, publicity, cosmetology, costume design and construction, set design/building/dressing, lighting design/implementation, sound design/implementation, front/back house duties, stage managing, and creating educational opportunities for the community.
