Dear Wayland Union Schools Families,

Beginning **October 1st, 2025**, Michigan law will require school districts to distribute safe storage informational notices annually, developed by the Department of Health and Human Services, to the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of every student. This requirement is now law and is part of the *Safe Homes, Safe Schools* legislation and is aimed at raising awareness and preventing unintentional firearm injuries.

As part of our responsibility under state law, we are sharing the following resources to help you understand what the law requires and how to comply:


